



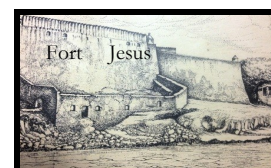

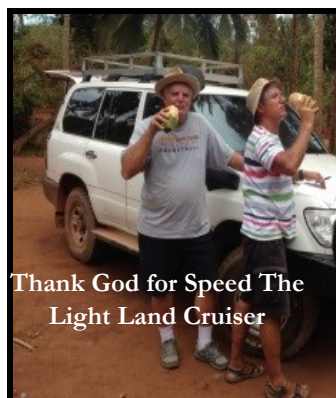
able to pray with

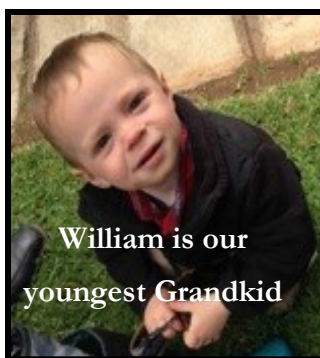
